SYLLABUS:

High Pointe will immediately begin implementing the International Dance Technique (IDT) syllabus.

IDT is a studio syllabus designed to develop plyometric agility, strength, fitness, flexibility and strong jazz technique in dancers of all ages and abilities.

This will enable teachers to progressively teach all students and ensure all of our technique classes are productive.

The end goal is to motivate and enable dancers to reach their full technical potential.

We will pair our IDT syllabus with a comprehensive strength and conditioning program. This program is written specifically for dancers to enhance performance, minimize injury-risk, and promote career longevity.

GROW LOCAL TEAM

This team is designed for students who are just starting out in competition dance, want a one day commitment during the school year, or play multiple sports.

Fall/Spring Weekly Commitment

This team will practice one time per week. They will have 45 min of jazz, 45 min of ballet, and a 30 min rehearsal, totaling 2 hours.

Tap and/or hip hop classes and/or dances are optional add ons for this team. While we will try to make it the same day, these rehearsals may be on an additional day of the week.

Summer Commitment

Team members must sign up for 3 weekly summer intensives.

Choreography camp for this team is mandatory and will be held Aug 5-9.

This team will participate in back to school bootcamp the week of Aug 19th and 26th.

Competition Info and Fees

This team will partcipate in our studio showcase, 3 dance competitions, and end of year recital.

The dance competition schedule will be released by July 1st.
